Badges are awarded for photographing a preset number of locations (see on reverse of page) Special awards will be given for best set of photos, best photo, oldest bike, smallest bike etc.



Be careful and do enjoy yourself - it's about Exploration & Having Fun.

The minimum accepted entry is 12 Points/Locations for a **BRONZE** Award

A **SILVER** Award is given for 18-23 Points/Locations

A **GOLD** Award is given for all 24 Points/Locations

A new entry process will be explained on the new website.

A photograph of the nominated Point/Location is required **with your bike visible**
You are encouraged to be creative.

The **Entry Fee** is €15.

If a **Pillion Passenger** is being entered, they must be clearly visible in the photograph and a **Seperate Entry Fee of €15** must be paid.

You may use as many Motorcycles as you wish and visit the Locations in any order as your prejudices dictate. Motorcycles must be ridden to the Points/Locations.

The **Closing Date** for entries is November 9th 2025. Late entries will **NOT** be accepted.
You have 9 months folks!
