THE IRISH PHOTO RALLY'S BASIC AIMS ARE...



To encourage people to get “out there” on their motorbike(s) & have some element of Fun, Adventure & Travel.

Ideally “out there” will be a bit off the beaten track and/or feature an unusual, historical or picturesque subject.

An interest in photography is not essential - but it just may add an additional dimension to your motorcycling.

The Irish Photo Rally, in the context of motorcycle riding, is **NOT** competitive.

Badges are awarded for photographing a preset number of locations (see on reverse of page)
Special awards will be given for best set of photos, best photo, oldest bike, smallest bike etc.



THE IRISH PHOTO RALLY'S RULES & REGULATIONS ARE...



Be careful and do enjoy yourself - it's about Exploration & Having Fun.

The minimum accepted entry is 12 Points/Locations for a **BRONZE** Award

A **SILVER** Award is given for 18-23 Points/Locations

A **GOLD** Award is given for all 24 Points/Locations

A photograph of the nominated Point/Location is required **with your bike visible**
You are encouraged to be creative but only upload **1 PHOTO** per point.

The **Entry Fee** is €15.

If a **Pillion Passenger** is being entered, they must be clearly visible in the photograph and a **Seperate Entry Fee of €15** must be paid.

You may use as many Motorcycles as you wish and visit the Locations in any order as your prejudices dictate. Motorcycles must be ridden to the Points/Locations.

Registration opens March 1st 2026 & closes September 30th 2026. However, your upload link will remain open until November 8th 2026. Late uploads **WILL NOT** be possible.
You have 8 months folks!
